

# Instruction for Money Card Template

Two files are SVG and one is pdf. The finished card will measure 7 " x 2 7/8"

**Step 1** download the template(s)

**Step 2** Save file by right clicking on page and select "Save As"

**Step 3** Open the file using your cutting machine or your machine's design canvas

**Step 4** Cut your design using any cutting machine that supports the extension svg

**Step 5** Print or Design your card with your selected embellishments

## Designing your card

You may wish to embellish or print a design on your card.

I prefer to print a design. If you would like to print a design, follow the steps below. If you print a design on your card, make sure you see the **example** to the right for correct placement of your design. The Brother ScanNCut will make score lines for you, but I prefer to use an awl and make my own, it looks neater.

### For Brother ScanNCut

Step 1 Select your design and print on 8.5 x 11 paper, **download "measurement" file. for placement of text.**

Step 2 Export the Money Card Template to your cutting machine.

Step 3 Scan the image you printed

Step 4 Fit the printed design in the scanned image.

Step 5 Select "Cut"

### For Cricut

Through **Design Space** download the .svg file

Select download and save.

### For Silhouette Cameo

I do not have this machine, but I believe you will need the .studio file to purchase the svg file. I have also provided a .jpg for you to download.

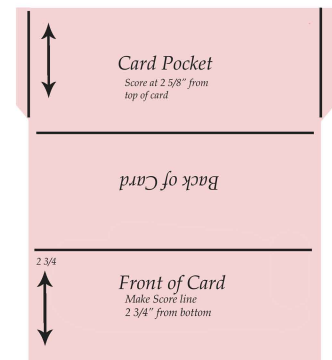
## Placement of the score lines.

If you make your own score lines, the measurements are provided see "**Measurements**" file.

**Card Pocket** For the card pocket" you will measure and score

2 7/8" from top of card

**Back of Card** Invert text
